



Tour 8: Sport & Nature-Bike Tour

This tour is more than a ride – it's a nature-based experience designed to showcase the ecological richness and scenic beauty of the Bodensee-Vorarlberg region, seamlessly connected with cultural flair and a warm welcome.

Saturday, October 4: Welcome Dinner

Your journey begins on Saturday in Dornbirn. We recommend arriving by train to ensure a comfortable and sustainable start to the tour. From the train station „Dornbirn Bahnhof“ it is just a ten-minute walk to the city centre of Dornbirn and our recommended hotel, Vienna House Martinspark.

» Welcome dinner – meeting point and directions:

We meet at 6:00 p.m. at the valley station of the Karren cable car for our welcome dinner. From there, we'll take the short cable car ride up together to the Panorama Restaurant Karren, where regional cuisine and a spectacular view await.

» Meeting point/address:

Valley station cable car Karren (Güttelestraße 6, 6850 Dornbirn),
Bus stop: „Dornbirn Karrenseilbahn“

» How to get there:

From our recommended hotel or the city centre of Dornbirn:
On foot: A scenic walk through the city, approx. 20 minutes
By bus: „Dornbirn Karrenseilbahn“

Take bus line 177 from Dornbirn Rathaus at 17:49, arriving at Dornbirn Karrenseilbahn at 17:59

After dinner, you're free to enjoy the evening atmosphere in Dornbirn's historic and lively city center, or simply relax at the hotel.

Guest mobility: Overnight guests in many Bodensee-Vorarlberg municipalities – including Dornbirn – receive a public transport ticket for all of Vorarlberg from the first night of their stay, provided by their accommodation.

Sunday, October 5: Bike tour

The day begins with individual breakfast and hotel check-out.

» Tour start – meeting point and tour itinerary:

We meet at 7:45 a.m. in front of hotel Vienna House Martinspark Dornbirn, where you will receive your rental bike.

» Meeting point/address:

Hotel Vienna House Martinspark Dornbirn (Mozartstraße 2, 6850 Dornbirn)

The 38 km tour begins at 8:00 a.m. in the heart of Vorarlberg's largest city. After a short ride through the urban area, you'll quickly find yourself surrounded by nature. The route leads through quiet landscapes, lush green fields and several nature conservation areas, including protected sections of the Lake Constance shoreline. You'll cycle along the water's edge into the city of Bregenz, where the Festspielhaus and lakeside promenade mark the gateway to the cultural heart of Vorarlberg.

Around 1:00 p.m., we'll enjoy lunch at a local restaurant in the heart of Bregenz. Following lunch, we take the Pfänderbahn cable car to the top of the Pfänder mountain (1,064 m), where a spectacular panoramic view awaits – overlooking the city of Bregenz, Lake Constance, and the surrounding Alps. After descending from the Pfänder, we will return our rental bikes and travel back to Dornbirn by train.

Departure information for the Cycle Summit in Constance:
Back in Dornbirn you will pick up your stored luggage at your respective hotel and continue your journey to Constance by organised bus transfer, where the Cycle Summit takes place.
